## Greetings from the Grounds

This month we will be putting our pre emergent spray on fairways and roughs. This spray is primarily for poa annua and helps keep us from having unwanted grassy weeds in our rough and fairways. Number two green is looking good with lots of green still in it, we have been busy fertilizing, top dressing, rolling and mowing we are currently at .160 height of cut our goal will be to get this green to .150 before winter arrives. We have raised fairways to .600 for winter and they look a little shaggy but it is necessary to withstand the winter traffic of carts and equipment. Our focus will shift to equipment maintenance and course clean up as move into the upcoming months. The driving range and chipping area have turned out great and we continue to fertilize and maintain these surfaces to provide an enjoyable experience for all the members, we hope everyone has spent some time practicing and improving their game while using these amenities, As always we look forward to seeing you on the course.
