Tournament Details

- Format:** “**Nine-Hole Match Around**”. Each Two-Man Team will play Five Nine-Hole Matches (Better Ball-Net) against each of the five other teams in their respective flight.
- Flights:** Teams will be PRE FLIGHTED based on the COMBINED COURSE HANDICAP of the two players. Each team will play 5 nine hole matches against the other 5 teams within their flight to determine and winner and runner up in each flight. The team with the most points is the flight winner. The team with the second most points is the flight runner up.
- Points:** There will be (9) nine points available in each nine hole match; One point will be awarded for winning the hole, ½ point for a tie going to each team.
- Tees:** All Men age 54 & under will play Blue Tees; Men ages 55-69 will play White Tees; Men age 70 & over will play Gold Tees and Men 80 & over will play the Red Tees. USGA Tee it Forward for Members who selected at the first of the year.
- Handicaps:** Players will receive 85% of their PLAYING HANDICAP. Each match will be stroked off the Low player’s playing handicap in the foursome for each 9-Hole Better Ball Match.
- Ties:** Ties in matches will STAND AS PLAYED. Ties in each flight will be settled as follows. THE HEAD TO HEAD match, or if the match tied, then break the tie by point total from the last two matches played, then by the point total for the last three matches played, and then if still tied the point total from the last four matches.
- Shootout:** Each FLIGHT WINNER will qualify for the “Championship Shoot-Out” to determine the Overall Champions! As well the RUNNER UP teams will be placed in a hat to draw one lucky duck to get into the Championship Shootout. The Shoot-Out format will be Modified Alternate shot with strokes awarded accordingly based on a combined team handicap. Modified Alternate Shot handicapping will be as follows: 60% of the A player’s course handicap added to 40% of the B players course handicap to get a total team handicap. 50% of the total team handicap will be taken to get a team playing handicap.

Greetings from the Grounds:

As hopefully you know by now, Tony has moved on and we are currently in our search for a new superintendent. We are almost complete with the round 1 interviews. Once round 1 is complete, we will reduce the field down to two candidates and make our final decision after a second round of interviews. The staff in our maintenance department has done a great job of continuing on and maintaining the course at a high level. The greens have completely healed from Aerification done in early June and are rolling great. We have been performing a weekly verticut and top dressing of the greens to remove thatch and help keep green speeds at a premium level. The latest project was grinding the roots in the trees right on #13. Dirt has been added to smooth the area and pine straw will complete the project. This will allow anyone to hit out of that area and not have to worry about striking a root. We hope to extend this project to other areas on the course. Thank you again for your patronage of Fox Run CC. We will see you on the links.

NEWS FROM THE HANDICAP COMMITTEE

The USGA and the Fox Run Handicap Committee rely on the membership to ensure that the club abides by and enforces the rules of golf.

The Fox Run handicap committee is tasked with the administration of the World Handicap system rules and regulations for the Fox Run membership.

In an effort to assist the handicap committee in conducting the due diligence of reviewing handicaps and scorecards, the committee is requesting all members who play a round of golf at Fox Run complete the following.



#1 Post all scores on the day of play. The World Handicap System updates the players handicap index nightly. During the update the score is factored into the calculations. As well, things such as playing conditions calculator is factored in. If you do not post the score day of the PCC will not take effect. #2 Deposit the scorecard in the box next to the handicap posting computer. It is mandatory that the scorecard for the round posted be filled out completely and deposited in the box next to the Handicap computer. Each scorecard should have the score for each hole, first & last name of each player, the date the round was played. The scorecard should be signed by the scorer and attested by another player in the group. In an effort to protect the field and enhance the accuracy, scorecards will be randomly inspected monthly by the golf committee. Those found not adhering the club policy of submitting all scorecards will be notified by the handicap committee. If the committee has to notify a member multiple times of scorecards not being turned in, eligibility for tournament play will be reviewed.

Speed of Play

Pace of Play

Play at Good Pace and Keep Up

Players should play at a good pace. The Committee may establish pace of play guidelines that all players should follow. It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and it is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group. Where a group has not lost a clear hole, but it is apparent that the group behind can play faster, it should invite the faster moving group to play through.

Priority on the Course

Unless otherwise determined by the Committee, priority on the course is determined by a group's pace of play. Any group playing a whole round is entitled to pass a group playing a shorter round.

The term "group" includes a single player.

All that being said, please at all times keep up with the group in front of you

Each group has 4 hours and 10 minutes to complete an 18 hole round. That is a very generous number for Fox Run, so we will expect to see each group finish in that time or less.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and we look forward to seeing each group right behind the group in front of them.
